Medical Information and Photo Consent Policy



Principle

To ensure that we are meeting Safeguarding and GDPR requirements, we ask all parents, or players over 18, to complete the medical information form. This includes consent to have your child / player (if over 18) to be photographed.

Policy –

Medical Forms will be available for every child, and will need to be filled in by a guardian, or the player themselves if over 18.

This will also include consent for photography.

If consented to have pictures taken, this may entail pictures being used on social media platforms, or for advertising / merchandise posts.

At tournaments / game days, players who cannot have their photo taken will be identified by a coloured arm band.

If you have any issues or you would like to discuss these issues, please contact the Welfare Officer.

Data Protection –

The information collected on this form is to allow Sheffield Giants American Football appointed medical staff at practice and game events to best support you with any medical conditions and/or injuries. The data will be held securely and only shared with the relevant medical staff for events. It will only be shared with members of the coaching staff if this is considered absolutely necessary for the coach to know and with your consent.

All data is used and stored in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR).
